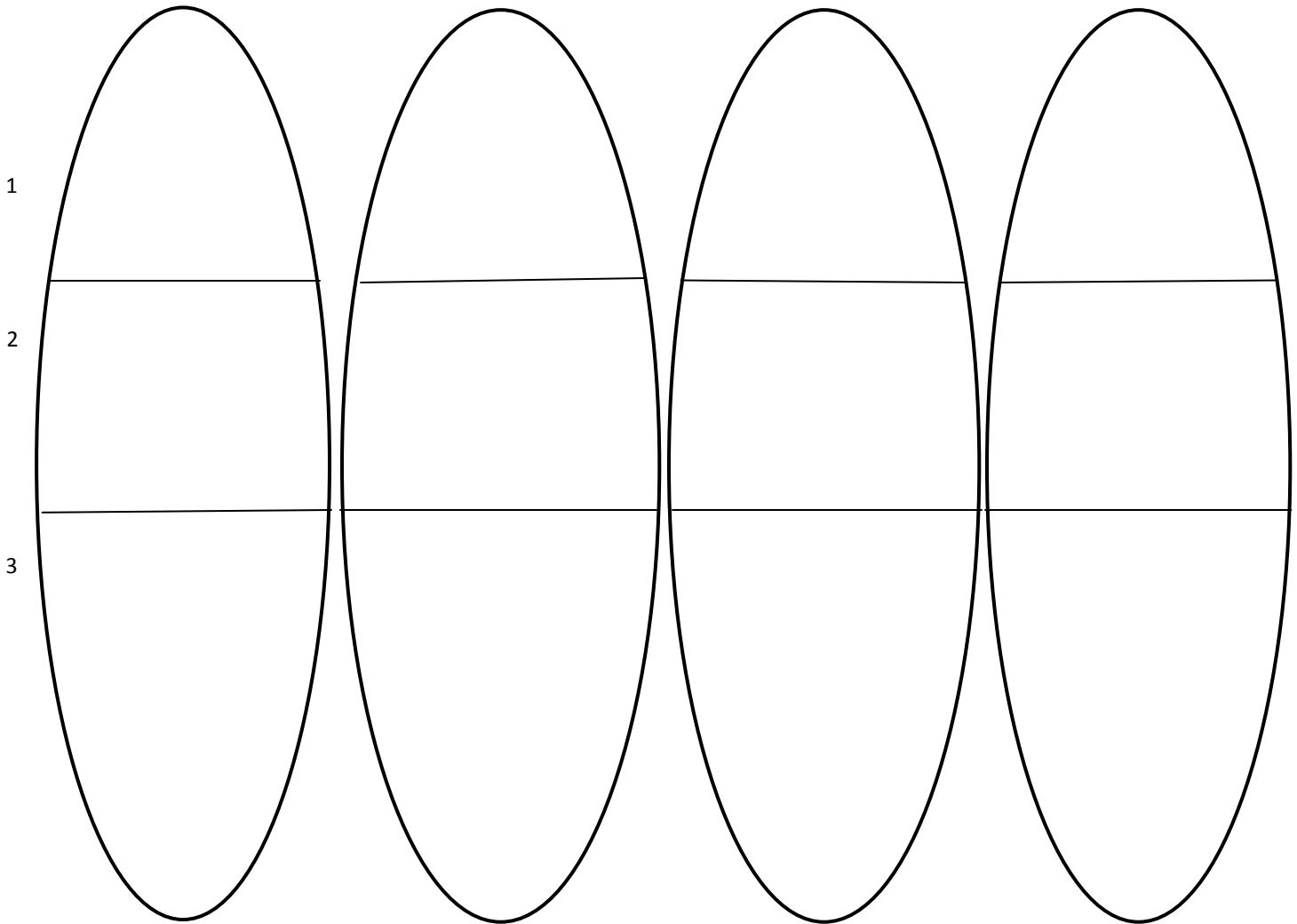


# CONFLICT & COMPROMISE GUIDE for RESEARCH & THESIS
